PROPER NET SET UP AT JMAC



THE CARIBINER ON THE TOP CHAIN CLIPS DIRECTLY TO THE METAL LOOP ON THE POST.

THE LOOP ON POST AND CARIBINER ON THE CHAIN ARE BOTH MARKED WITH GREEN TAPE.

THE CHAIN AND ATTACHED CARIBINER STAY ON THE TOP PORTION OF THE NET.

THE TOP STRAP CONNECTS DIRECTLY TO THE LOOP ON THE NET VIA A SMALLER CARIBINER. NEITHER HAVE ANY TAPE ON THEM BUT THE NET IS MARKED "TOP CRANK".







THE CARIBINER ON THE BOTTOM CHAIN CLIPS
TO THE LINK ATTACHED TO THE POST.
BOTH THE LINK ON POST AND CARIBINER ARE BOTH
MARKED WITH YELLOW TAPE. THE LINK STAYS ON
THE POST. THE CHAIN AND ATTACHED CARIBINER
STAY ON THE BOTTOM PORTION OF THE NET.

THE BOTTOM STRAP CLIPS DIRECTLY TO THE LOOP ON THE NET VIA A SMALLER CARIBINER. NEITHER HAVE ANY TAPE ON THEM BUT THE NET IS MARKED "BOTTOM CRANK".







THE FINISHED SET UP SHOULD LOOK LIKE THIS.
IF THE NET IS NOT STRAIGHT LIKE IT IS IN THE
PHOTO, THEN THE NET MAY BE UPSIDE DOWN AND
YOU NEED TO CHECK THAT IT IS ATTACHED
PROPERLY (YELLOW TO YELLOW, GREEN TO GREEN).

THE PADS GO ON LIKE THIS. THE SIDE WITH THE SINGLE STRAP GOES TOWARDS THE COURT.

THE SIDE WITH MULTIPLE STRAPS GOES AWAY FROM THE COURT.
